<u>John 1:41</u>

In the beginning, the serpent, who is the devil, lied to Eve, and she and Adam ate the forbidden fruit. This sin caused them, and all Adam's children, to became dead to God. But right away God promised to send a savior who would destroy the devil and his works. (Genesis 3:14-15) Throughout the ages, God continued to promise to send this savior to mankind. God made these promises through his prophets. This promised savior of the world was called Messiah (which means Christ).

Think about John 1:40-41.

One of the two who heard John speak and followed Jesus was Andrew, Simon Peter's brother. He first found his own brother Simon and said to him, "We have found the Messiah" (which means Christ).

Think about John 1:45.

Philip found Nathanael and said to him, "We have found him of whom Moses in the Law and also the prophets wrote, Jesus of Nazareth, ... "

Think about John 1:48-49.

Nathanael said to him (Jesus), "How do you know me?" Jesus answered him, "Before Philip called you, when you were under the fig tree, I saw you." Nathanael answered him, "Rabbi, you are the Son of God! You are the King of Israel!"

"Rabbi" means: my master.

• What did Nathanael proclaim to Jesus?

Think about John 1:50-51.

Jesus answered him (Nathanael), "Because I said to you, 'I saw you under the fig tree,' do you believe? You will see greater things than these." And he said to him, "Truly, truly, I say to you, you will see heaven opened, and the angels of God ascending and descending on the Son of Man."

"The Son of Man" is a name Jesus called himself.

• What great things did Jesus say Nathanael would see?

Think about <u>Mark 14:61-62</u>.

... the high priest asked him, "Are you the Christ, the Son of the Blessed?" And Jesus said, "I am, and you will see the Son of Man seated at the right hand of Power, and coming with the clouds of heaven."

• What did Jesus say the chief priest would see?

Think about Mark 13:26-27.

And then they will see the Son of Man coming in clouds with great power and glory. And then he will send out the angels and gather his elect from the four winds, from the ends of the earth to the ends of heaven.

In this passage Jesus is telling his students what will happen at the end of this age.
